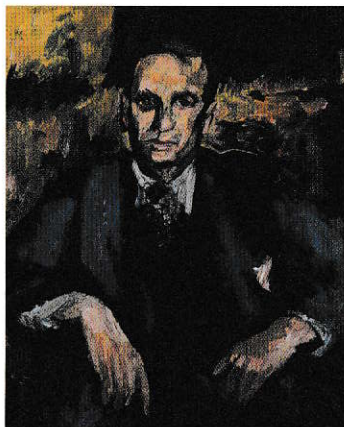
### Curator's Tour: **Bomberg**
